## GENERAL HIGH-SCHOOL CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

Check with your umbrella school for the requirements specific to your situation.

Math: 4 Credits - Including Algebra I, II, Geometry and a fourth higher-level math course like Pre-Calclus or Consumer Math (students generally must be enrolled in a mathematics course each school year).

Science: 3 Credits - All science classes at DT include labs. Options include Biology, Chemistry, Advanced Biology (A\&P), Intro to Animal Science and Nutrition and Health Science.

English: 4 Credits - We recommend Foundations of English for English I and then any Lit class or HS Composition can satisfy English II, III or IV.

Foreign Language: 2 Credits - Spanish, French and Italian are offered

Social Studies: 3 Credits - including U.S. History, World History or 20th Century History, Government ( $1 / 2$ credit) and Economics ( $1 / 2$ credit)

Fine Arts: 1 Credit (not required at all umbrella schools) - Choir, Musical Theater, Set Design, Graphic Design, Art, Music

Physical Education And Wellness: 1.5 Credits - We offer Health (Nutrition Science can also count) and Fit Fight. There is also a Karate class that is offered separate from Discipleship Tutorial at 4:30 on Tuesday.

Personal Finance: 0.5 Credits

Electives: We also have a wide variety of offerings in the visual and performing arts, technology, business, test prep, and more.
