## GENERAL HIGH-SCHOOL CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

## Check with your umbrella school for the requirements specific to your situation.

Math: 4 Credits - Including Algebra I, II, Geometry and a fourth higher-level math course like Pre-Calclus or Consumer Math (Students must be enrolled in a mathematics course each school year).

Science: 3 Credits - All science classes at DT include labs. Options include Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Marine Biology and Anatomy \& Physiology

English: 4 Credits - We recommend Foundations of English for English I and then any Lit class or HS Writing can satisfy English II, III or IV. HS Writing is designed to be able to be taken alongside any Lit class.

Foreign Language: 2 Credits - Spanish or Italian is offered

Social Studies: 3 Credits - including U.S. History, World History or 20th Century History, Government ( $1 / 2$ credit) and Economics ( $1 / 2$ credit)

Fine Arts: 1 Credit (not required at all umbrella schools) - Choir, Musical Theater, Set Design, Graphic Design, Art

Physical Education And Wellness: 1.5 Credits - We offer Health, Emotional Health, and Self Defense (P.E., female only). There is a Karate class that is offered separate from Discipleship Tutorial at 4:30 on Tuesday.

Personal Finance: 0.5 Credits

Electives: We also have a wide variety of offerings in the visual and performing arts, technology, business, test prep, and more

ENGLISH: Jr High Lit and Jr High Writing correlate to cover the same books, so students are strongly encouraged to take both classes in the same year to build a strong understanding of literary analysis and writing techniques, especially in preparation for high school. However, students can take either class alone to satisfy an English credit, Lit classes in this case will assign 4 papers throughout the year that have basic assessments and Writing will have students read and evaluate books at home.
